Dear Mr. Walker:-

I thank you for yours of May 17th and am writing to Hon. Geo. Malone, as per copy herewith.

Regarding your ability to enforce the contract for sale of land, would suggest that you examine the contract and you will find that the only thing we obligated ourselves to do in the matter was to return the \$1000.00, which we did, and which as a matter of fact was never used or enjoyed by the writer, he having returned you the identical check which you sent him in the matter without having cashed it or used it in any way.

Under these circumstances and under the law, as we are advised very positively, to return to you the \$1000.00 check absolutely ended all our obligation.
