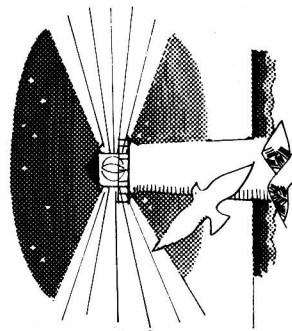
— Obituary —
