Dear Mr. Walker:

We have your letter of September 27 asking for statement of rents paid since February 1, 1932, on your building in Athens.

On February 5, 1932 we paid \$200.00 to Mrs. J. E. Horton, in accordance with your instructions; on March 4, 1932 we paid \$100.00 to W. B. Vaughn - we continued these \$100.00 monthly payments through August 1933; on Sept. 1, 1933 we paid \$125.00 and continued the \$125.00 monthly payments through December 1933; on January 9, 1934 we made payment of \$137.50 and like \$137.50 payments continued through December 1934; on January 1, 1935 we paid \$200.00 and have continued these \$200.00 monthly payments to date.

Of course, all of the payments with the exception of the first one of \$200.00 were made payable to W. B. Vaughn.
