

## DOROTHY WEAVER MALONE-WILEY – 1930 - 2010

The funeral for Dorothy Weaver Malone-Wiley 79, of Athens, Alabama will be Friday, October 29 at 12 Noon at Little Elk M. B. Church in Athens, AL with Pastor Eugene C. English, Pastor officiating.
