KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that whereas William Ryan Walker, deceased, owned at the time of his death, a large law library and office furnitures and fixtures located at his late office in the City of Athens, Alabama, and also a Chandler Cope Automobile and;

Whereas the said William Ryan Walker died intestate and without any direction for the disposal of said personal property, and;

Whereas R. H. Walker has qualified as administrator of the estate of said William Ryan Walker, deceased, and;

Whereas, we Lee R. Walker, widow, and Eloise W. Richardson, Maria W. Rives, Ada W. Farmer and Jennie R. Walker, sisters of said deceased are all the heirs at law and devisees of the estate of said William Ryan Walker, deceased, except the said R. H. Walker, a brother, who is also adminsitator, and all the persons interested in said estate except creditors, and;

Whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient by all of us that said law library and office furniture and fixtures^{and automobile} be sold at private sale rather than under an order of sale by the Probate Court having jurisdiction of said estate:

Now, therefore, inconsideration of the premises, we hereby authorize R. H. Walker, as such administrator, to dispose of said law library, furniture and fixtures^{and Chandler automobile} at private sale, in whole or in parcels, for cash or on credit, or partly cash and partly on credit, at such price or prices as he may set or shall be able to obtain; and authorize him to advertise said property for sale in such manner as he may desire and to exercise his own judgment in the manner of disposal and to incur such expense in advertising or selling said property as he may deem expedient, and we agree that he shall not be liable for a dev^savit by reason of any such sale and shall only be accountable for the net proceeds of any such sale or sales, after deducting the necessary costs and expenses thereof.
