
Dear Sir:

The City of Sheffield contemplates purchasing or constructing a municipal water works system, funds to be obtained by the issuance of municipal bonds under the Goodwin Act, HR-265 of 1932.

It has been called to my attention that the Water Company now operating in this City may attempt to amend the Goodwin Act so that the bonds contemplated could be issued only by cities in which there is no existing water works system, either privately or publicly owned.

Kindly keep me advised as to any steps taken by the Alabama Water Service Company regarding this matter.
