KN ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT, Made and entered into by and between Luther D. Glaze, party of the first part, and R. H. Walker, J. B. Sarver and Nute Hatchett, parties of the second part, witnesseth:

Party of the first part has sold to second parties 320 acres on the Nick Davis pike, ^{ten}ten miles east of Athens, known as the Johnnie Moore place, on the following terms and conditions: \$650 cash, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and \$6,000 cash on January 1st, 1920, the assumption of a mortgage of \$7,200 now on the place in favor of W. T. Sanders, administrator, with interest from March 20, 1919, and the balance secured by second mortgage on the place, due and payable Jan. 1st, 1921 with interest at 8% from Jan. 1st, 1920.

Party of first part agrees to execute deed to parties of second part on Jan. 1st, when payment of \$6,000 in cash is made to him; parties of second part to then execute second mortgage for balance due as stipulated above.
