In re: Street Assessment - Anderson Home

Dear Mr. Walker:

We were somewhat surprised to learn this week that Jen and the others are responsible for these street assessments. We are quite reluctant to assume this obligation unless Jen's property is legally liable therefor or to prevent you suffering personal embarrassment. We realize the handling of the estate has been quite an undertaking and appreciate the thought and effort you have put into it.

We understand there are future payments that will become due and wonder if it could not be arranged to take care of them out of any undivided portion of the estate if it is legally liable for them. We are told that unless the present payment is made by the 14th, court cost will probably be added. However, we believe Goodrich is trying to get some sort of reduction, but rather than to be subjected to additional cost, I am enclosing a check made to you as trustee in the amount of \$13.50 to be used in part or as a whole to meet Jen's portion of this present assessment payment. We were advised by Goodrich that this is her prorata share. It is my thought that if he procures a reduction, you could deposit this check to your account and check against it for the correct amount, allowing Jen a return of the difference.

If it is necessary to make this payment, we should like it made in a manner that will not further obligate us ^{UNLESS} ~~except~~ her property is legally liable or to save you embarrassment as trustee. We are interested in knowing the outcome of the matter and future possibilities in adjusting it.
