Olay Quience Roberts, Jr. was born in Mt. Pleasant, Tennessee on September 10, 1947. He departed this life on January 14, 2004, in Madison, Alabama. He was the third born child to Mrs. Mary Ruth Roberts Oliver and the late Mr. Olay Quience Roberts, Sr. He was a graduate of Clark High School in Mt. Pleasant, Tennessee.
