### **"DON'T GRIEVE"**

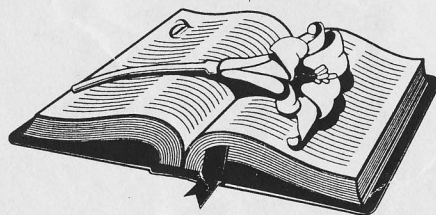
*Don't grieve for me,
