May God hold you in the palm of his hand.*

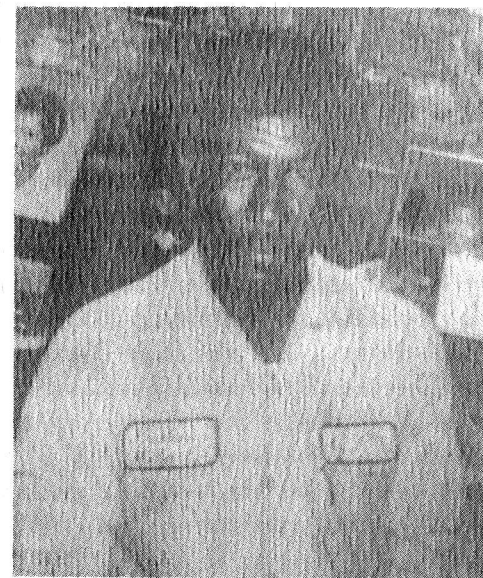
