God wanted me now. He set me free.*

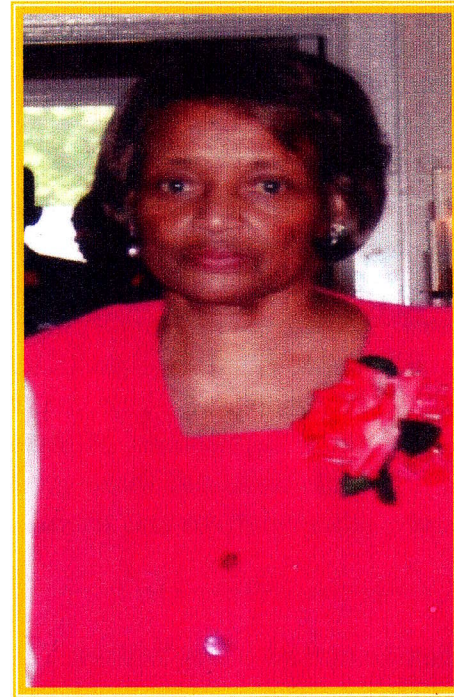
