We beg to acknowledge receipt of yours of the 18th inst enclosing check for \$25.00 which we have placed to your credit. We can not give you any additional advertising just now. The \$18.00 contract we will be glad to have again when completed.

With reference to the diamond to be mounted into the ring setting that you sent, we beg to say that it will be impossible to furnish a duplicate of the stone that was lost for \$115.00, much less the \$100.00 that you suggest, the lady wishes to pay. A stone of the character described will cost \$147.00. This would mean a white and perfect stone. If there should be no objection to a stone with a small imperfection we might be able to furnish one at the price mentioned, (from \$100.00 to \$115.00) but to furnish a perfect pure white stone for \$100.00 is absolutely impossible.
