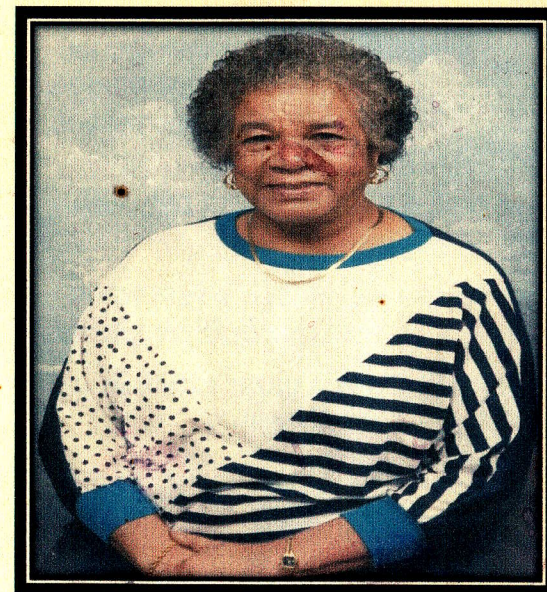

Much of my strength comes from knowledge and respect you

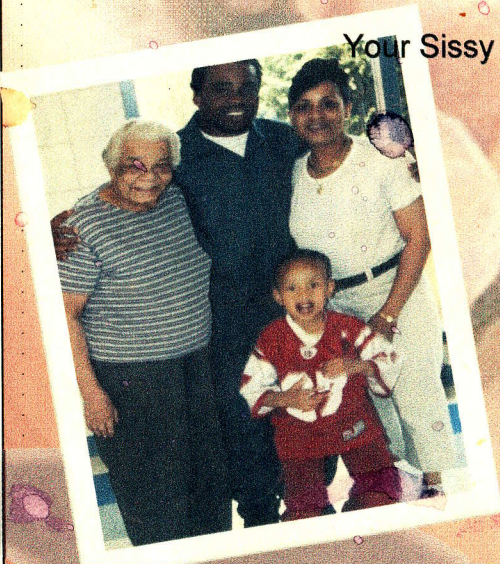
