

## Willie Percy Yarbrough

Willie Percy Yarbrough, 91, of Rockford, passed away Tuesday, September 20, 2016, after a short illness. He was born February 14, 1925, in Athens, Alabama, the son of Nish and Sudie Mae (Thatch) Yarbrough. His family moved to Rockford in 1932.

Willie graduated from Rockford High School, and was drafted into the US Army soon thereafter, serving three years in the China Burma India Theater (CBI) in
