Dear Senator:

I am enclosing herewith a letter received by Governor Miller from Secretary of State Cordell Hull, Washington, D.C., which was referred to the office of Secretary of State.

You will note on page 20 of the General Acts of 1932, that the "Lame Duck" resolution was ratified by the Legislature of September 17, 1932.

Since State legislation should be enacted to change the date of the meeting of Presidential electors as set out in Section 540 (in 1932 the Electors met in this office on the first Wednesday in January), I am referring this letter to you. I do not know whether the resolution as set out in the Acts of 1932, page 20, is sufficient as to the term of Members of Congress and United States Senate. Probably the date in Section 424 should be changed to read January 3rd instead of March 4th.
