I left Houston about thirty days; our stenographer who was to look after correspondence secured a much better position just as I was getting ready to leave, so instead of holding her, I closed the office, and have had mail follow me.

Just as soon as I return to Houston I will gladly give you the information asked for.

We have been unable to operate for over thirty days owing to flooded conditions, and during our shut down, I have taken the opportunity to visit our share holders as far as possible.

I regret very much to learn of Mr. Walkers death, and when there is information that I can give you, I will be glad to do so, and regret that I am unable to give you the data asked for quickly at this time.
