
Dear Sir and Friend:-

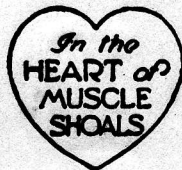
