Lankford received his formal education at Trinity High School in Athens, Alabama. He received his Bachelor of Science and Master of Education degrees from Alabama Agricultural and Mechanical University, Normal, Alabama.

Lankford was employed at Boeing Aerospace for ten years. He later worked as a Vocational Evaluator at the Huntsville Rehabilitation Center, where he provided dedicated and compassionate service to numerous clients until his retirement.
