Sir:

I have the honor to enclose herewith for your information a print of AN ACT "To provide for changing the time of the meeting of Congress, the beginning of the terms of Members of Congress, and the time when the electoral votes shall be counted, and for other purposes" (Public-No. 286-73d Congress), approved June 5, 1934.

Inasmuch as it appears probable that changes in existing state legislation governing elections will be found necessary in order to conform with the provisions of the aforesaid Act, I am bringing the matter to your attention in order that the appropriate authorities of your State may be duly apprised of the terms of the statute.

A similar communication is being addressed to each of the Governors of the several states of the Union.
