*I'm left here to grieve and now I am the one*

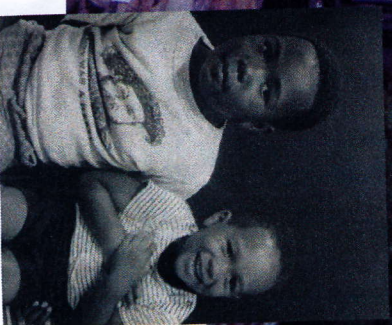
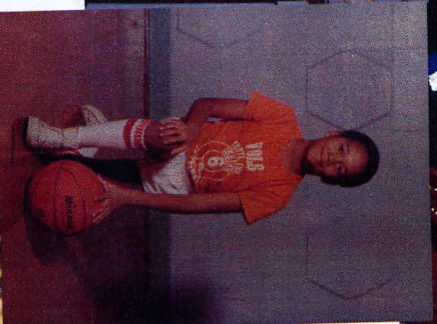
