Dear Mr. Walker:-

I herewith enclose copy of my letter to Dr. A. E. Morgan, Chairman of the Board of Directors of the TVA, and also copies of some other correspondence. I will ask Leonard to call by and see you. We both thank you for the interest you have taken in this affair. Hope you will give him your views and avoid if possible the impression that we are seeking to bring political pressure. You might bring to his attention that my relationship with the public and with the personnel of the office has been harmonious. I believe the entire force is with me with the exceptions of Newman and Rieger. It might also be brought to his attention that I live at Muscle Shoals where the headquarters for the acquisition of the lands for Pickwick Dam will be maintained. The situation presented is that of the organization being turned over to men whose training and employment has been with the power company, and are not in sympathy with the purposes of the Act, and that men who for years supported the principles of the legislation are being gradually eliminated.
