My dear Mr. Walker:

In reply to your request of June 7 addressed to Mr. Neely concerning an extension of time for the removal of tenant houses from property at Harris Station, may we advise that in view of the fact that these houses should have been removed not later than March 1, we should like to have these buildings removed as we advised you by June 15, 1936. However, since your father has been ill we are extending this time to June 20. We hope that this will be ample time, and that these buildings will be removed by that date as we are closing our removal activities and must have all buildings removed. This date, June 20, confirms our agreement over the telephone as of this date.

We hope that your father is improving rapidly, and will soon be well again.
