

TWENTY-THIRD PSALM

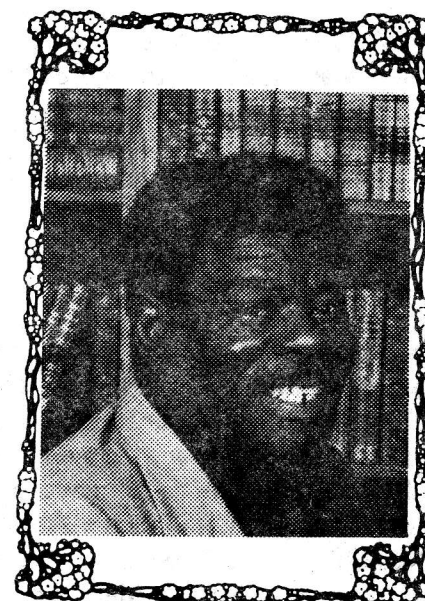
