# Remembrance

In the Southern atmosphere in Limestone County, Alabama, a child was born to the late Rev. and Mrs. Amos Robinson, whose name was Amos Robinson, Jr., born April 25, 1912.

He was brought up in a Christian home and at an early age he joined the St. Matthews P. B. Church and was baptized by the late Rev. Ned Patrick.

He served as a deacon and later was called into the ministry.

He devoted his life to the ministry and worked faithfully until the Lord called him to rest.

He was called to pastor the Mt. Lebanon P. B. Church, Gurley, Alabama.

In December 1950, he was called to pastor the St. Bartley P. B. Church, Huntsville, Alabama. During his pastorage, the present structure was erected and services began in December 1965. Under his leadership, more than 400 members were added to the church.

For many years his ministry extended to a vast radio audience and through his efforts, many wandering souls were led to Christ.

He served as Moderator of the Indian Creek Primitive Baptist Association, President of the Tri-State Sunday School and B. T. U. Congress, a member of Financial Committee and Board of Directors of the National Primitive Baptist Convention of America, a member of the Greater Huntsville Ministerial Association, member of the Morning Star Lodge No. 50-A, and many other civic organizations.

On Sunday evening, May 10, 1970, at approximately 9:45 p.m., the Lord felt that He needed a special flower to complete His bouquet, so He looked around and whispered, "**AMOS, you are very tired, come home to rest, My good and faithful servant**".

The immediate survivors include: a lovely, devoted wife, Mrs. Cleo Robinson; a daughter, Mrs. Annie B. Lockhart; and a son, Mr. Dinsmore Robinson; eight grandchildren; five sisters, Mistress Corine, Susie, Henrietta and Annie B. Robinson, all of Huntsville, Alabama; Mrs. Lucinda Nobles of Indianapolis, Indiana; four brothers, Messrs Ollie, Willie, Ezell, and Roosevelt Robinson, all of Huntsville, Alabama; one daughter-in-law, Mrs. Josephine Robinson; one son-in-law, Mr. George Lockhart; five sisters-in-law, two brothers-in-law, a host of nieces, nephews, relatives and other friends.
