# OBITUARY

Kenneth Wayne Cain was born on June 29, 1960 to the late Jimmie and Inez Lucille Mahaley Cain. He departed this life on Sunday, May 17, 2020 at his home.

During his childhood he was a Cub and Boy Scout under Scout Master, the late Reverend John R. Collier. Kenneth was a 1978 graduate of Athens High School. Some of his employment included Monsanto Chemical Plant, GE Appliances, and Goodyear Dunlop Tire.

Kenneth confessed Christ as his Savior in August 1973 and became a member of the Pleasant Grove Cumberland Presbyterian Church under the pastoralship of the late Reverend Willis Fletcher, Sr. He was a faithful member, attended Sunday School and was a member of Choir No 2.

After his ordination as an Elder at Pleasant Grove Cumberland Presbyterian Church he taught the Adult Sunday School Class. Elder Kenneth Cain accepted his call to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and was licensed and ordained by the Huntsville Presbytery. He served as vice president of the Huntsville Presbytery Sunday School Convention.

In 2003, Reverend Kenneth Cain united with the Tennessee Valley Presbytery where he served as moderator and vice moderator for several terms. On September 1, 2010 Mt. Olive Cumberland Presbyterian Church in America issued the Call to Pastor to the Tennessee Valley Presbytery for Reverend Kenneth Cain to become their pastor. He was installed as pastor of Mt. Olive Cumberland Presbyterian Church in America on Sunday, November 14, 2010 until he resigned effective January 27, 2019 due to his health.

He was preceded in death by his brother, Fred Cain, and Dorothy Jean Mahaley (reared as his sister).

Reverend Cain leaves to cherish his memories: one sister, Vanessa Marie Cain Collier of Madison, AL, reared together as sister and brother, Latina Rochelle Mahaley White (John) of Elkmont, AL, two aunts, Shirley Ann Mahaley Smith and Georgia Mae Mahaley of Athens, AL, one brother-in-law, Ernest Lee Collier of Madison, AL, and nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
