Dear Mr Walker:

I have been out of the state for some time-- including another visit to old Dr Carver at Tuskegee-- and I just havent had time to attend to Miss Holt's matter, after finding out at first that the man I was to contact was out of town for several weeks. I am going into Nashville Monday and clear that matter up and write you. I imagine it will come out all right.

I have also been very busy from soon after daybreak until almost midnight each day writing the story of Dr Carver; it is now in the East and I have great hopes of landing it , although the old man will probably die as a result of overwork in his polio experiments after it appears.

Seems to me you were going to send me some studies you made years ago in Populism etc. Wesley Stout of the Saturday Evening Post was powerfully interested in them.
