## Obituary

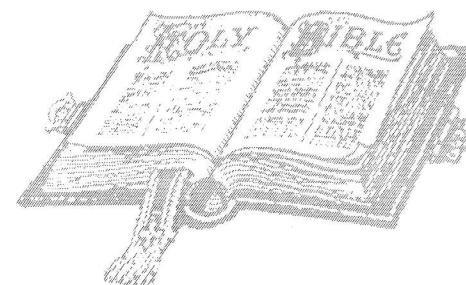
