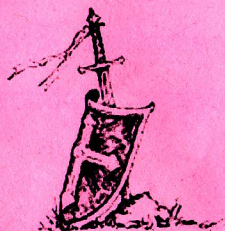
She professed hope in Christ at an early age and was a long time member of St. James Cumberland Presbyterian Church before her illness.
