

I'M FREE

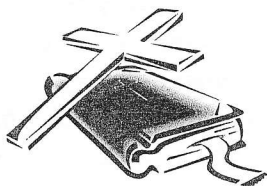
Don't grieve for me, for now I'm free

Farewell!!

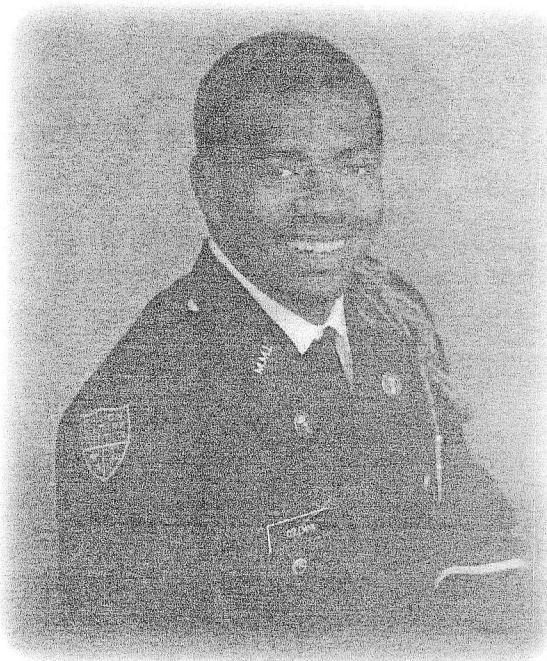

He promised he would be right there.*

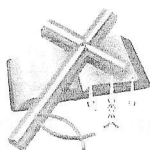
