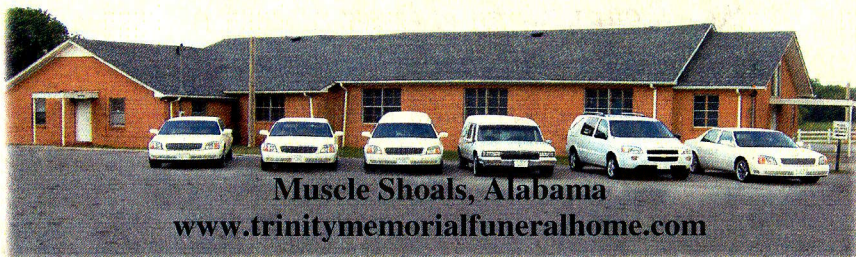

*When I Must Leave You*

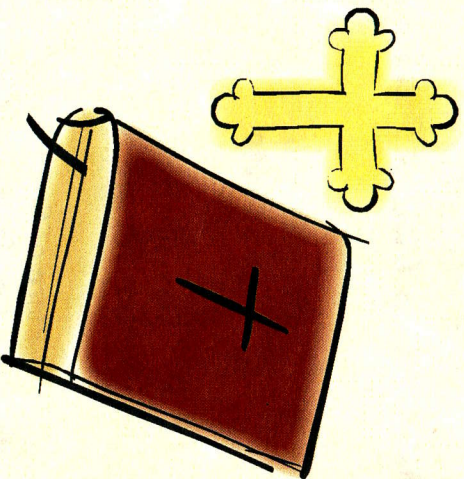
When I must leave you for a little while,
