On yesterday you turned over to me a letter from Mr. Chambers of Florence, Alabama. At the time you handed me his letter and paper attached to it, I thought that we could attend to it, but an examination of the letter and the form of lease attached to it, indicates that this is purely a private matter and that our office could not properly have anything to do with it at all.

Under the law, Mr. Speaker, we are not authorized to handle matters of this kind.

Moreover, for reason which I will not mention in this letter, my suggestion is that you let this matter alone. I will explain to you in detail when I see you.
