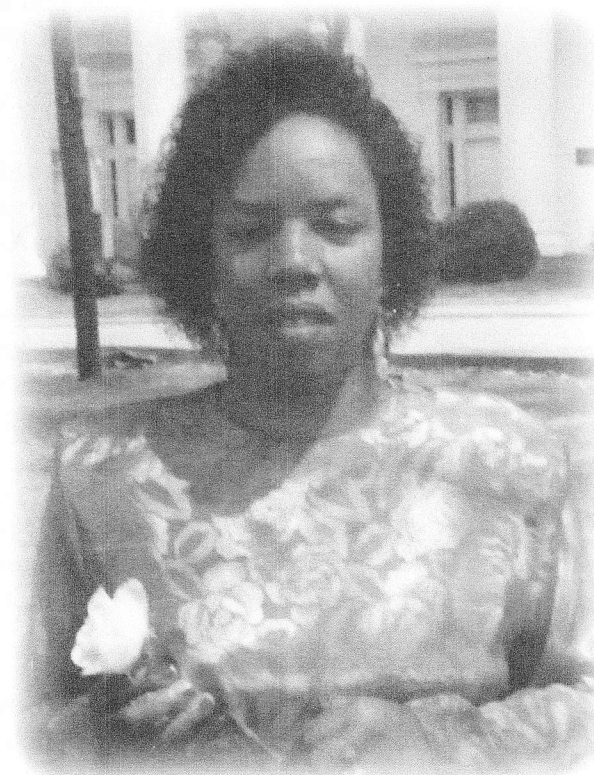

**Janice Washington** was born to the late Lou Ella Washington on October 1, 1959 in Limestone County. She departed this life on Monday, May 4, 2009.

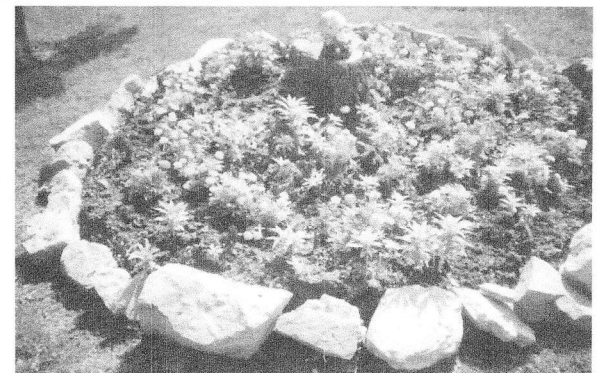
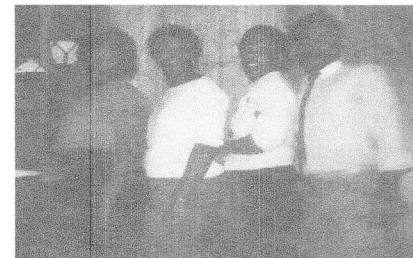
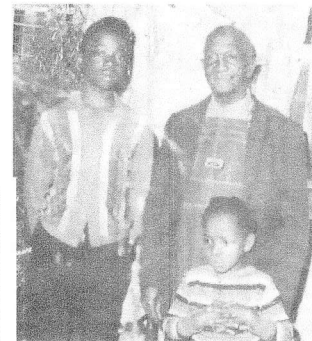
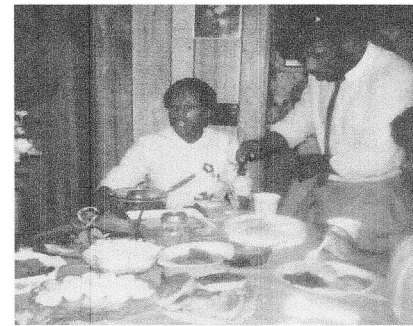
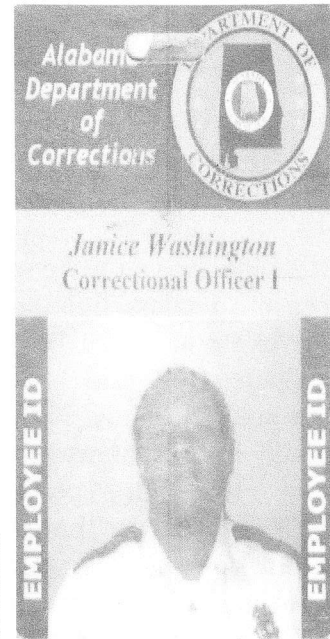
