You are correct about our "marking time" when they jacked the bond up to \$25,000 but the District Attorney states that he would be willing to approve acceptance of \$20,000. We had a slight hope that we could locate a party willing to sign for \$5,000. making the total \$15,000, but there seems to be some doubt about our success in that line. I have good reason to believe if we could today sign for \$10,000. we could get James released; but unfortunately our friend that was in Court last week ready to sign for \$5,000. has had a complete breakdown and is now in Coopers Well, Miss. He will not return for about 6 days. In the meantime we will have to wait.

Bessie arrived this afternoon, and as I know the Criminal Sheriff quite well, arranged for their meeting in his private office. She bore up wonderfully well considering. James also went through the ordeal nicely. Mamie was with us. Outside of those mentioned we had absolute privacy. It helped quite a little. Bessie is loud in her praises of the grand manner you have come to her assistance. May you never regret it.
