For part of us went with you, the day God called you home.**

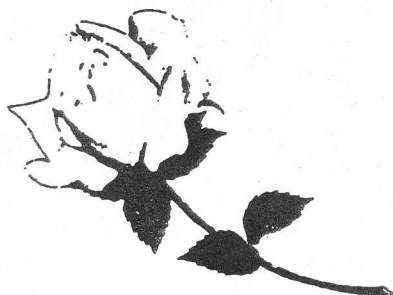
