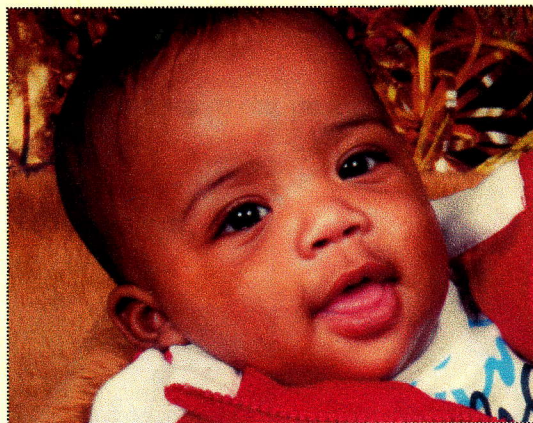
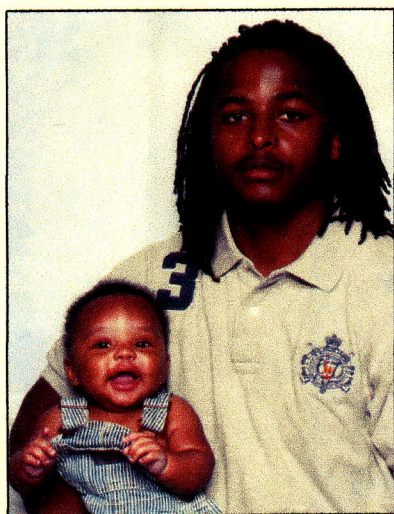
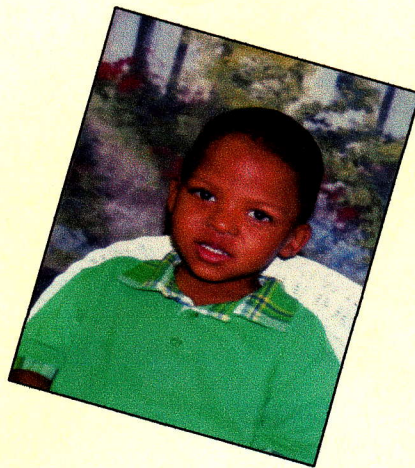

"When I Must Leave..."

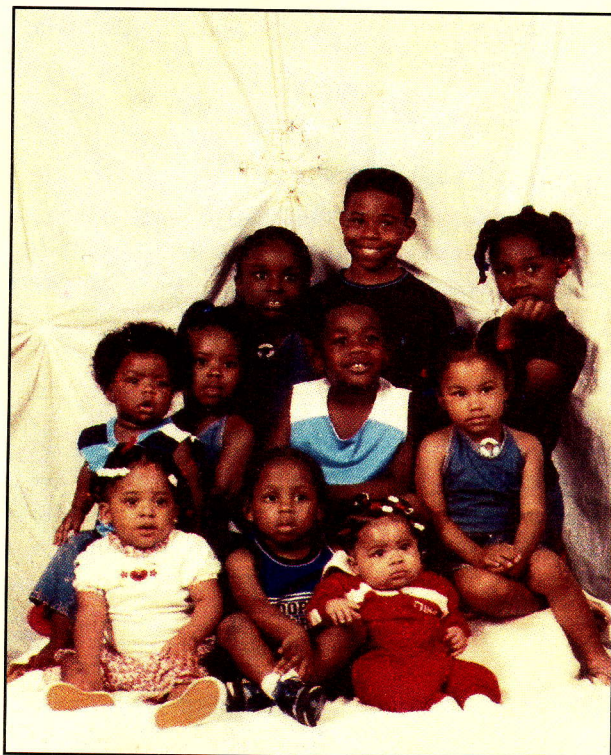
*When I must leave you for a little while,
