Obituary

On July 5, 1926 in Limestone County, Alabama, the late Brock Mahaley and Earline Witchard Mahaley were blessed with a baby girl, Inez Lucille Mahaley. God called his servant home on January 24, 2014 at her home.

She married the late Mr. Jimmie Cain, Jr., on December 27, 1947. To this union three children were born, one of which deceased during infancy. They also reared Dorothy Jean Mahaley and Latina Rochelle Mahaley as their own.

Lucille confessed Christ as her Savior in August 1941 and became a member of the Pleasant Grove Church under the pastorship of the late Reverend Sam Mitchell. For many years she served as a member of Choir No. 1, the Missionary Society, President of the Usher Board, and mother of the church. Mother Cain enjoyed attending the Missionary Societies of the Huntsville Presbytery, serving as Vice President for several years, the Alabama Synod and the General Assembly. She was also a member of the Ministers and Elder Spouses.

She was a member of the Naomi Star Chapter No. 653 OES. Along with others she spearheaded an annual Thanksgiving Program that consisted of several churches worshipping together on Thanksgiving Day. She volunteered by collecting donations for the March of Dimes and the American Cancer Society. Lucille was a member of the Limestone County Chapter of the NAACP.

Throughout the community she was known for her love of cooking Soul Food Sunday Dinners, delicious cakes, making be bops, wearing beautiful head attire (hats), children and pets.

She was preceded in death by her brothers, John Benny Mahaley, Lucian Mahaley, Melvin Mahaley, Sr., and Bennie Lee Mahaley; sister, Cora Armstrong and stepson, Fred Cain.

Mother Cain leaves to cherish her precious memories: three daughters, Dorothy Jean Mahaley of Athens, AL, Vanessa (Ernest) Collier of Madison, AL, and Latina (John) White of Elkmont, AL; one son, Reverend Kenneth Cain of Athens, AL; eleven grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, three great great-grandchildren; two sisters, Shirley Ann Smith and Linda Sue Mahaley of Athens, AL; one sister-in-law, Georgia Mae Mahaley of Athens, AL; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

"During her illness, she would often invite us to recite Psalm 23 and sing the old Congregational Hymn, "I'll Never Die While Jesus Lives" with her.


