

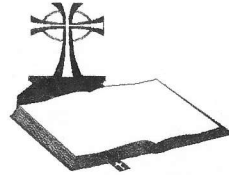

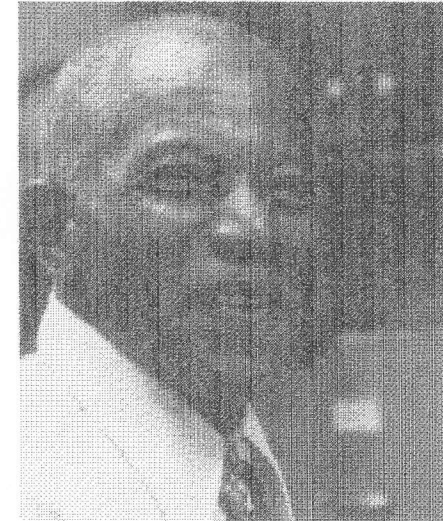

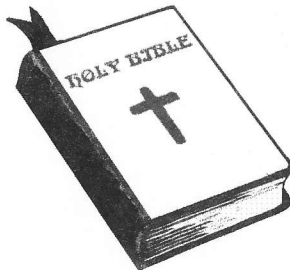
He was blessed in life because he walked closely with the lord . His angel visited him in his home on Wednesday Nov. 21, 2001.
