County of Sumter. } presents, that I, Robert  
Henry Walker, of said County and State, being  
of sound mind and disposing memory, hereby  
make this my last will and testament, hereby  
revoaking all former wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1: I direct that all my just debts  
and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my  
decease as convenient.

Item 2: I hereby give and bequeath to my  
son Robert Henry Walker ~~thirty~~ thousand  
dollars, <sup>(\$3000.00)</sup> to be paid out of my insurance  
money, or, if none, out of my estate, to be  
used solely for his education and any  
unpaid sum shall fall into the residuum  
of my estate.

Item 3: I hereby give, devise and bequeath  
to my wife and all of my children, shown and  
shown alike, all the residuum of my estate,  
real, personal or mixed, or to which I may be  
in anywise entitled, provided, however, my  
said wife and children shall only use  
the income therefrom until my youngest  
child arrives at the age of twenty-one  
years, when said estate shall then be  
divided by my executor, hereinafter named,  
between herself and my said children.

Item 4: I hereby nominate and appoint  
my wife as the executor of this will, and  
request that no bond be required and no  
accounting in any Court of her acts and  
doings as such executor shall be made.
