Dear Mr. Walker:

This will acknowledge yours of the twenty-first, including check to cover News Review shipment.

We note you say you will send us check on note before the end of the month and, I would again caution you that it is imperative that this check reach Birmingham by not later than Saturday morning of this week. I am going to suggest that you send the check by return mail, even though you care to date same June 30 and we will hold it until that date.

As stated in our letter of June 19, it will take \$78.38 to bring the note to a current basis, as of June 30, including interest and, I hope you will be able to send the full amount.

Answering your question as to the quantity of news stock we have on hand, size 32x46, would advise that as we stated in our letter of the nineteenth, we have 20 bundles (40 reams) for a total of 2,180 pounds.

This stock is available to you at the code price which, in 500 pound lots is \$3.25, or in ton lots at 3¢.
