

Pastor Frederick L. Lewis was born February 5, 1971 to Brenda A. Lewis and the late Jessie Lewis Jr., on Saturday, December 6, 2003 he departed his life at Huntsville Hospital. Along with his father, a brother, Robert L. Lewis, also preceded Frederick in death.

Elder Lewis confessed hope in Christ at an early age and joined Thurgood Memorial Christian Methodist Episcopal Church. He was baptized by Pastor Theodore Bone and joined the Beaver Dam Primitive Baptist Church on August 8, 1998. Elder Lewis publicly declared his acceptance of his call into the ministry to the Pastor and Board of Officers of the Beaver Dam Primitive Baptist Church on September 25, 1999. He preached his first sermon in conference in on October 2, 1999 and was licensed (October 28, 2000) and ordained (October 19, 2002) by the Indian Creek Primitive Baptist Association, where the Elder Eugene Lewis is Moderator. On September 28, 2003 he was installed as Pastor of the Pilgrim Rest Primitive Baptist Church

Fred graduated from Parker High School and joined the United States Army on December 26, 1992. While stationed at Fort Hood in Texas he married the former Angela Renee Gray and they were blessed with two children. After his separation from the Military, Fred and Angela moved to Alexandria, LA, where he became manger of Rex TV and Appliances Center. When the family relocated to Huntsville, AL Frederick became assistant manager of the Huntsville Rex TV and Appliance Center.

After moving to Huntsville Frederick felt the need to continue his education. He enrolled in Drake Technical College where as an honor student and a member of the Dean's List, he completed a course of study in Graphic and Printing Technology in the fall of 2001. While at Drake Frederick was a member of the All USA Academic Team for Community and Junior Colleges, president of the Student




Government Association, and a member of the National Vocational and Technical Honor Society. He then matriculated to Athens State University.






